THE FACILITATORS

The Host Church will be responsible to recruit small group facilitators to help work with the seminar participants. The facilitator/participant ratio should be 2:6. This means 1 adult facilitator should be recruited for every 3 kids participating. The responsibility of the facilitator during the seminar is to facilitate small group discussions with the kids and help them work through their **KIDS HOPE WORKBOOK**.
